- **Open from the beginning of May to the end of September, depending on the weather**
- **Use of facilities against a fee, reserved for swimmers at their own risk!**
- **Parents will be held liable for the actions of their children!**

Welcome to AQUAPARK!

In order to make sure that fun remains safe for all, we kindly ask you to comply with the following important safety regulations and rules of conduct:

General

- Admission is strictly reserved for swimmers.
- Children under the age of 8 years must be accompanied by a person of legal age responsible for supervision.
- Wearing a swim vest is mandatory for all without any exception while using the facilities.
- The instructions of supervisory staff must be observed.
- Using the facilities is only possible against a fee and during opening hours.
- Leave the AQUAPARK immediately in case of thunderstorm or storm.
- Taking along pointed objects and wearing shoes is prohibited.

Behaviour on the modules

- Pay attention to signboards
- Act with consideration. Do not push or shove.
- At bottlenecks and in case of congestion, start moving only when the area is free.
- Never dive below the modules.

- Use slides only in a proper position (sitting or lying).
- Move carefully on wet surfaces (risk of slipping).
- When falling into the water, keep calm, your swim vest provides buoyancy. Swim to the next module or exit.
- Smoking on the modules is prohibited.

Health and safety:

- Using the facilities is not recommended for persons with cardiovascular issues, epilepsy, or similar diseases, as well as pregnant women.
- No admission for persons under the influence of alcohol or drugs.
- Do not underestimate the physical strain of your activities and UV-radiation.
- If you feel overtired, cold, or exhausted, take a break immediately.
- It is recommended to take off valuable objects (jewellery, watches, etc.) before using the facilities.
- Report any damage to modules to staff without delay.

Special advice:

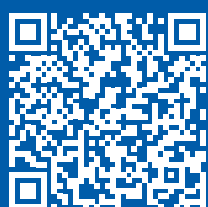
- Limited number of visitors – please mind the information you receive upon admission.
- Taking photos and filming (videos) is permitted only when other visitors are not shown without their consent.
- In case of an emergency signal (whistle or siren), leave the AQUAPARK immediately.
- Facilities may be closed due to bad weather; the entrance fee will not be refunded.

Responsibility and liability:

- Visitors use the facilities at their own risk.
- Parents and persons in charge of supervision are responsible for their children.
- No liability is assumed for lost or damaged objects.
